## What is a campus?

A campus is a building, or buildings, in a community area where people can access local services.

Different services are currently provided in the Wootton Bassett area, including leisure, library and youth services. These services are currently offered from many different locations, some of which are housed in buildings no longer fit for purpose.

Campuses could be new or existing buildings and may also be used to provide partner services. One of the main ideas behind campuses is to create flexible space which can be used for a variety of purposes and by a variety of people or organisations. The campus might include leisure, adult social care, youth services, a library, a cafe and internet services.

A Community Campus is providing services for residents of Wootton Bassett and the surrounding areas.
